Powder Puff Rules

- Class is open to 1980 and newer Ford and Mopar cars or 1977 and newer GM.
- Doors and trunks must be welded or chained. (For every inch of weld, 1 inch must be open)
- Hood may be welded, chained or bolted. If bolted, maximum of 4 bolts none through the frame.
- Drivers door bar, dash bar, and rollover bar mandatory.
- Passenger bar and rear bar optional.
- Maximum 31" tires.
- Drivetrain must remain stock.
- Suspension must remain stock.
- Bumpers may be trimmed and inverted, but not welded. Two (2) chains per bumper is recommended.
- Fresh built cars may NOT have trimmed wheel wells.
- Re-run cars may have enough trimming for wheel clearance.
- Frames may not be notched or altered.
- Body panel may not be bolted together.
- Transmission lines must be stock or looped together. Tranny coolers are prohibited.
- Transmission shifters are optional.
